QUICK INSTALLATION GUIDELINE

Saniexpert can be connected to any type of toilet having a straight ceramic wall discharge, in compliance with European standards.

It is connected by inserting the toilet discharge into the rubber coupling on the tank and fixing it with the clamp supplied.



The outlet is located on the top side of the Saniexpert.



In addition to the toilet, Saniexpert can be also connected to other units (as bidet, shower, washbasins...). Those units can be connected to the short sides of the appliance.



The Saniexpert should not be installed to appliances, such as washing machine and dishwasher, if connected to the toilet.

In the event that the auxiliary inlets are not used, assemble the relative closing cup.



The saniexpert can be connected both to the shower tray or bathtub. In this case the lowest level of water must be at least 10 cm above the Saniexpert Installation floor.

All sanitary equipment connected must allow the interruption of water flow and must have its own syphon. It is recommended not to connect the Saniexpert to more than 1 appliance operating potentially continuously (es. no more than 1 shower).
